In accordance with Grand Junction Code of Ordinances, 15.44, the 2012 International Fire Code Chapter 56, NFPA 1124 and the Colorado State Revised Statutes Title 12, Article 28:

The applicant hereby requests a permit to display and sell fireworks within the City of Grand Junction and/or the Grand Junction Rural Fire Protection District, subject to the following requirements, together with any and all legal requirements that may apply.

Applicant is required to provide the following information before permit is issued:

- List of fireworks to be sold (one sample of each item if requested)
- City or County sales tax license (City license, call 970.244.1521; County license, call 970.248.7140)
- Proof of Comprehensive General Liability Insurance (at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence)

INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS

A Fire Department inspection of the sales area is required. Applicant must call the Fire Department at 970.549.5800 to schedule an inspection. Business hours are 8AM to 5PM, Monday through Friday. Inspection times are limited to 8AM - 3PM, Monday through Friday.

		Provide no less than two 2A-rated pressurized-water fire extinguisher in a readily accessible location.
		"NO SMOKING" and "NO SALES UNDER THE AGE OF 16" signs shall be posted in conspicuous locations in sale area. Sign letters shall not be less than 4" in height and 1/2" width
		Signs as required by Colorado State Law shall be posted (CRS 12-28-102)
		Electrical wiring and equipment must be in accordance with the National Electric Code.
		Sales Inventory must be available for inspection. Samples may be tested by inspectors for compliance with state and local codes. Sales area must be fully stocked prior to inspection.

ALL REQUIRED ITEMS MUST BE COMPLETED AND ACCEPTABLE TO THE INSPECTOR AT THE SCHEDULED ON-SITE INSPECTION TIME. ANY DEFICIENCIES OR MISSING ITEMS WILL RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF THE APPLICATION FEE AND APPLICANT WILL BE REQUIRED TO REAPPLY FOR A SALES PERMIT.
