SPRING
CLEAN-UP**

***North Side of North Avenue
Starts April 5th - 7 a.m.***

***South Side of North Avenue
(includes areas of Orchard Mesa
& the Redlands)
Starts April 12th - 7 a.m.***

DO NOT put items out before March 29, 2021.
Any items out before that date are subject to a
Notice of Violation and possible \$1,000 fine.

- Items must be out by 7 a.m. on April 5th for (north of North Avenue) or April 12th for (south of North Avenue) - crews move quickly and will not return to an area once they have been through it.
- Items need to be in ONE pile in the street, up against the gutter, in front of YOUR house - separate notification on where to place piles will be sent to houses with no on-street parking.
- Only YOUR items should be in front of YOUR house.
- Piles larger than one dump truck load (approximately 10 cubic yards) will be subject to a \$150 charge, per extra load.
- Do not place piles on private property - on lawns, landscaped areas, sidewalks, in driveways, etc.
- To avoid damage to private property, please keep piles at least 3 feet away from buildings, fences, mailboxes, cars, etc.
- Keep piles away from items you do not want removed - trash containers, lawn ornaments, compost piles, bicycles, etc.
- Consider donating or recycling your unwanted and reusable items. (see www.gjcity.org for a list of charitable organizations)
- The Mesa County Landfill has instituted additional fees for Mattresses & Box Springs, so we will no longer pick those items up.

Hazardous Waste

- Batteries
- Antifreeze
- Aerosol Cans
- Fluorescent Light Tubes
- Freon
- Gasoline/Grease/Oil
- Insecticides/Pesticides
- Road Flares
- Spa & Pool Chemicals
- Ammunition

Electronic Waste

- Televisions/Stereos
- Computers/Keyboards
- Printers/Copiers/Scanners & Fax Machines
- Cell Phones/PDA's
- VCR/DVD Players
- Gaming Consoles
- Amplified Speakers
- Cables/Cords
- Calculators
- Cameras/Camcorders

Other prohibited items:

- Refrigerators
- Air Conditioners
- Air/Gas Cylinders
- Asphalt Rubble
- Brick & Concrete Rubble
- Engines/Motors
- Freezers
- Fuel Tanks
- Items longer than 6 ft
- Liquids of any kind
- Shingles
- Tires
- Mattresses & Box Springs
- Microwaves

For a small fee, any Mesa County resident can dispose of tires (year-round) at the Mesa County Landfill.
