RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES DUAL STREAM RECYCLING & YARD WASTE


How to prepare:

All materials must be sorted into correct bin before collection. Materials that meet these guidelines will be accepted. If collection occurs in the alley, containers should be placed on the same side of the alley as the trash cans. Recycling and trash cans should be placed at least 3 feet apart from each other and from other objects. Assistance for persons with disabilities is available.

Program pricing is based on the size of the trash can:

- 48 gallon bin: \$11.50 per month
- 64 gallon bin: \$15.75 per month
- 96 gallon bin: \$25.00 per month

Customers may choose to opt-in to receive (2) 64-gallon dual stream recycling bins at no additional charge. Recycling bins are picked up every other week.



Recyclables must be out by 7 a.m. on pickup day



Prohibited items:

- Electronics/E-waste
- · Batteries of any kind
- · Hazardous materials: asbestos, chemicals, oils, paints, cleaners, needles, etc.
- Food waste
- · Construction debris/wood
- Medical waste: used gloves/masks, medicine

DUAL STREAM RECYCLING

Blue Bin (Containers)

#1, #2, and #5 plastic bottles, jars and jugs (remove and discard all plastic lids), aluminum and steel cans/lids (remove and discard all labels from aluminum), #5 lids and tubs,

#1 clear blister/clamshell, #1 clear cups

Completely drain containers, rinse of food

KEEP OUT: #3, #4, #6 and #7 plastics, glass, plastic bags of any kind, aluminum foil, aluminum tins, scrap metal, foam of any kind, packing material, large storage bins, furniture, toys, trash cans, plastics marked "biodegradable" or "compostable", motor oil containers

Yellow Bin (Paper/Cardboard)

Clean, flattened, unwaxed corrugated cardboard, cereal/cracker boxes, soda/beer containers, brown paper sacks, toilet paper tubes, paper towel tubes, newspapers, magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper egg cartons, mail (open and remove all plastics and magnets), paperback books, white or pastel office-quality paper, shredded paper (may be contained in paper bag)

KEEP OUT: Plastic bags/wrappers/film, paper cups, waxy paper plates, tissues, toilet paper, paper towels, packing material, waxy juice/milk cartons, wet/greasy/oily material, photographs

Remove anything plastic or metal

SEASONAL YARD WASTE

Light Green Bin (Yard Waste Compost)

Leaves, grass clippings, brush trimmings, tree limbs (less than 4 ft in length and less than 12" in diameter), hay, straw, weeds

KEEP OUT: Plastic bags, dirt, rocks, sod, root balls, construction debris, wood, food waste, pet/animal waste
